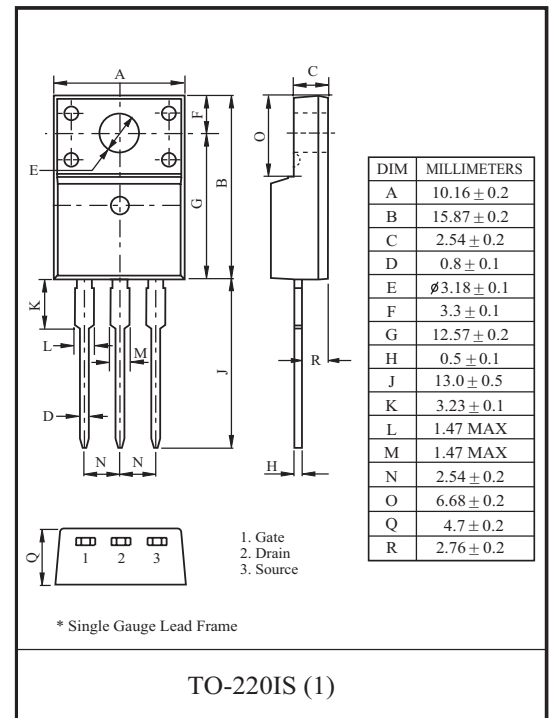
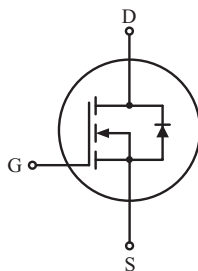

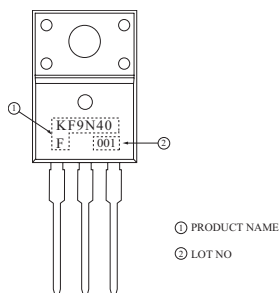


Fig1. $I_D - V_{DS}$

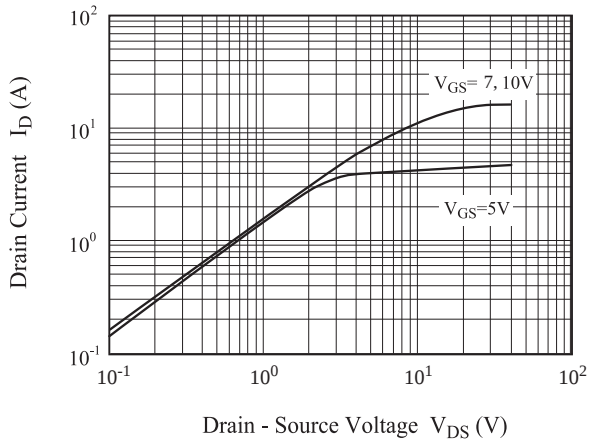


Fig2. $I_D - V_{GS}$

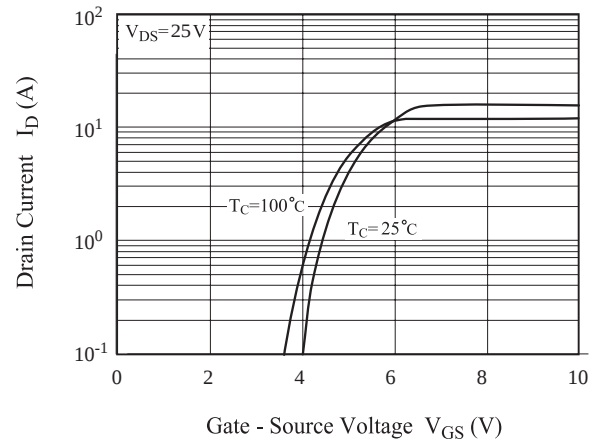


Fig3. $BV_{DSS} - T_j$

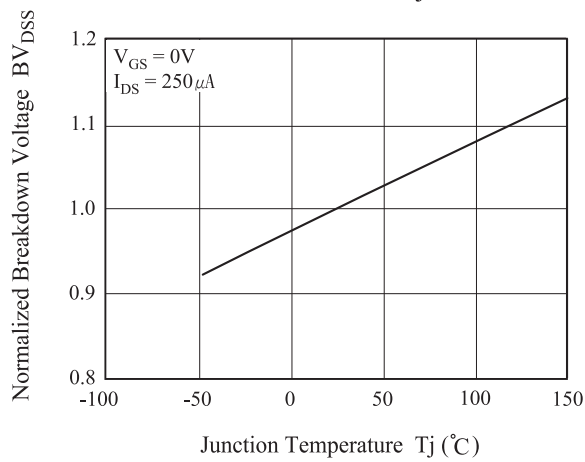


Fig4. $R_{DS(ON)} - I_D$

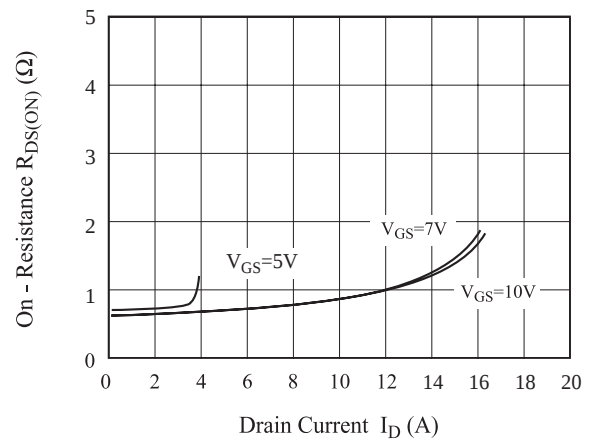


Fig5. $I_S - V_{SD}$

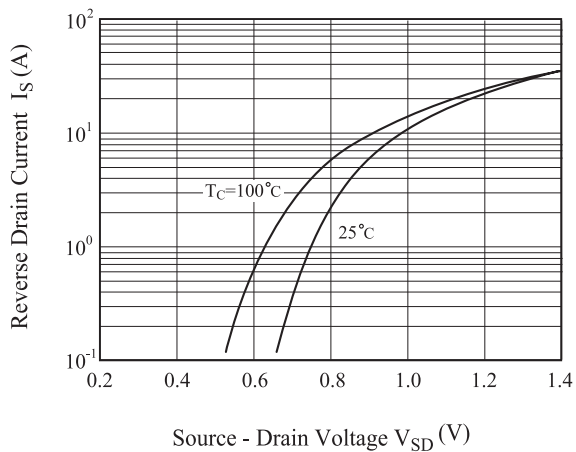


Fig6. $R_{DS(ON)} - T_j$

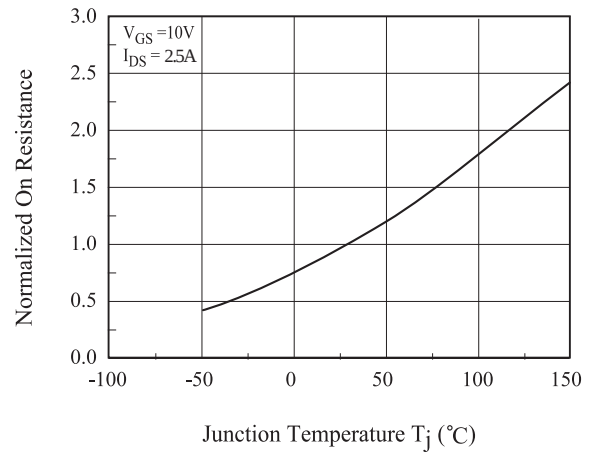


Fig 7. C - V_{DS}

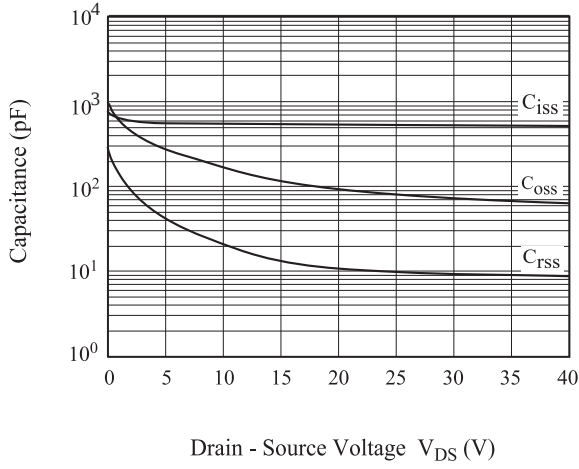


Fig8. Q_g - V_{GS}

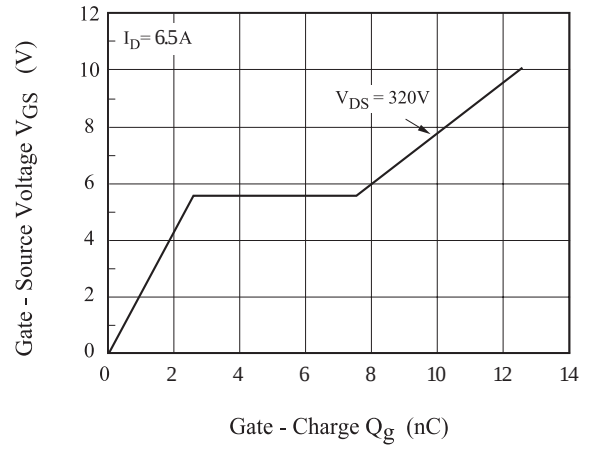


Fig9. Safe Operation Area

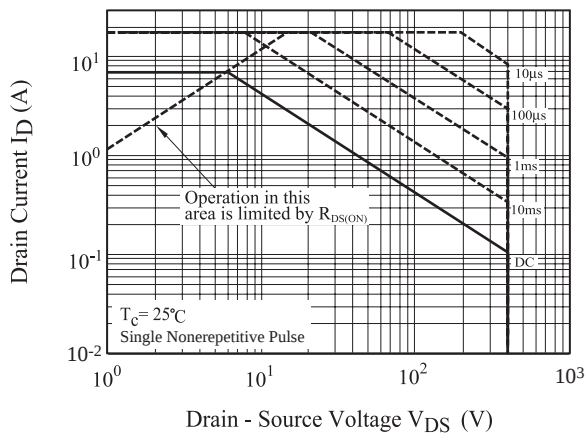


Fig10. I_D - T_j

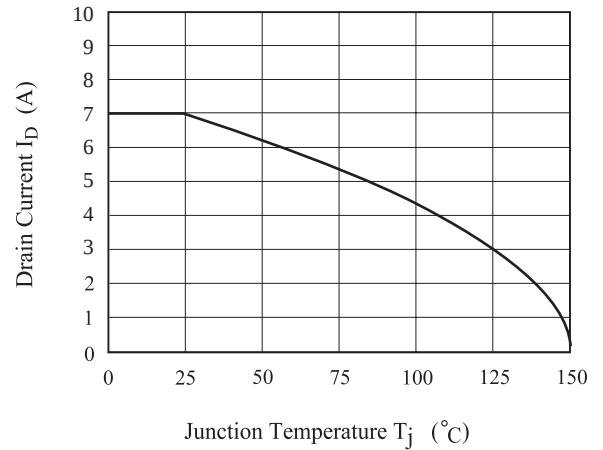


Fig11. Transient Thermal Response Curve

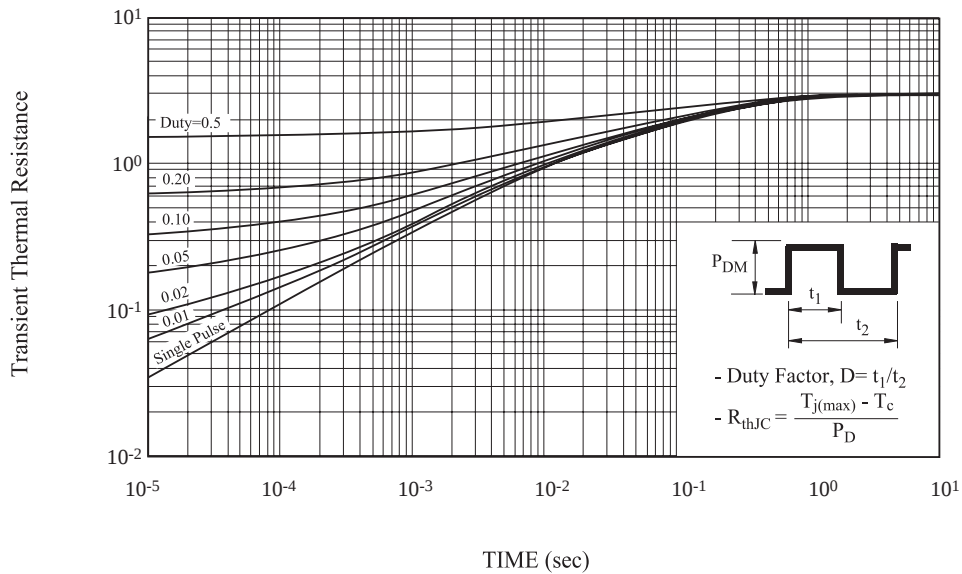


Fig12. Gate Charge

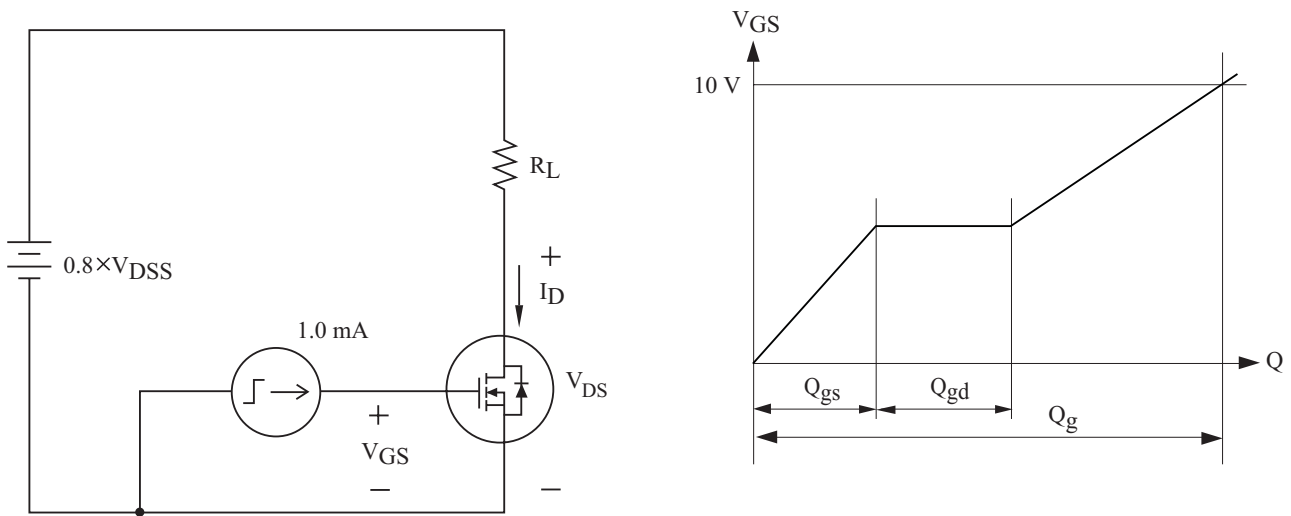


Fig13. Single Pulsed Avalanche Energy

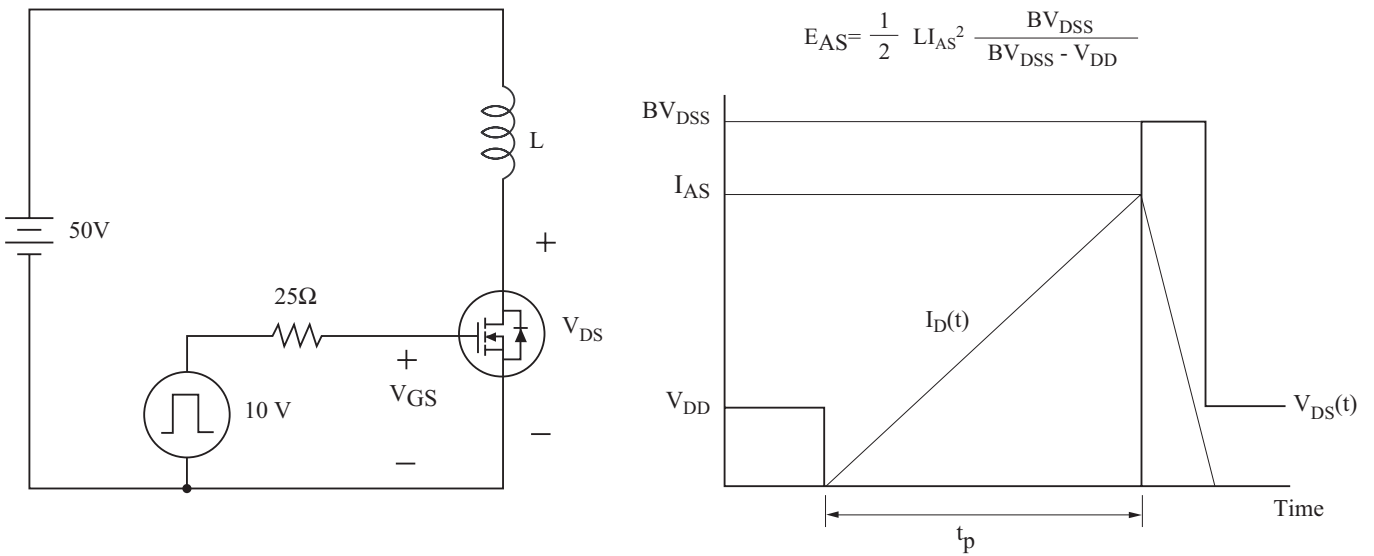


Fig14. Resistive Load Switching

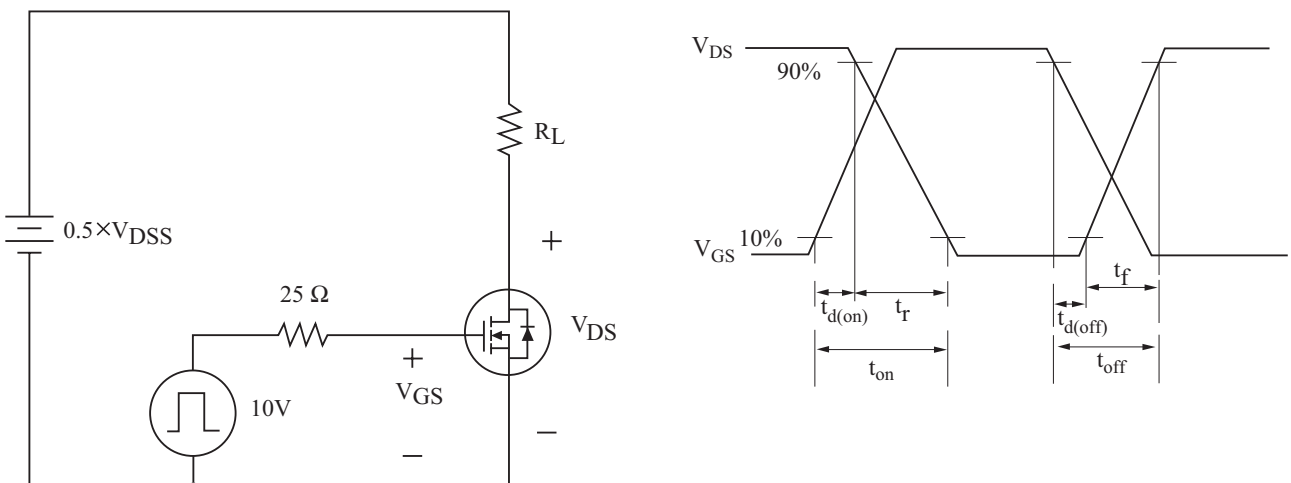


Fig15. Source - Drain Diode Reverse Recovery and dv/dt
